PHASE 2: SECTORAL STRATEGY DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

MSWGs conduct sector level participatory assessment of vulnerability and develop sectoral adaptation strategies and measures for governments, civil society, private sector (details below)

MF provides initial framework for MSWGs, reviews progress, resolves issues, & provides ongoing guidance (meetings with secretariat support)

PHASE 3: CONSOLIDATED STRATEGY

- 3.1 Multistakeholder Forum integrates sectoral recommendations into a draft NASPA (MF with secretariat and consultant support)
- 3.2 Post draft NASPA on website, distribute to stakeholders, and invite written feedback and submissions (managed by secretariat)
- 3.3 Organize multistakeholder workshop process (national and 2 regional workshops, organized by the secretariat)
- 3.4 Refine and finalize the NAPA (MF meetings with secretariat support)
- 3.5 Prepare detailed supporting documents (profiles of initiatives, projects, and activities for the national government, state governments, civil society, private sector, international agencies, and media)

PHASE 4: INTEGRATION OF STRATEGY INTO KEY FEDERAL AND STATE POLICY DOCUMENTS

- 4.1 Identify key target federal and state policy documents (based on work in Phases 2 and 3)
- 4.2 Consult with responsible entities to determine policy review procedures, opportunities, and needs
- 4.3 Prepare draft text for integration of climate change adaptation into identified policy documents
- 4.4 Promote adoption of proposed text through participation in established review procedures, advocacy, and legislator workshops
